

Dear [MP],

I am writing to you today to ask you to get behind a growing, and extremely important campaign to publish the Home Office's report into the characteristics of grooming gangs.

As you will be aware, towns across the UK have been plagued with rape gangs, in a several-decade scandal which has affected up to hundreds of thousands of young British girls.

According to research by Quilliam, a counter-extremism think-tank, "84% of 'grooming gang' offenders were (South) Asian, while they only make up 7% of total UK population and that the majority of these offenders are of Pakistani origin with Muslim heritage."

It is not hard to see that there must be some link between culture/religion and the rape gang crisis. That's why, very sensibly, then-Home Secretary Sajid Javid commissioned a report into the characteristics of grooming gangs, which would explore this link and help to put an end to this horrific wave of abuse.

The report has now concluded, but the Home Office have refused to publish its findings.

The Home Office are covering up the findings of one of the most important reports in recent years, in what will most certainly be looked back on in future as a national scandal. The public have a right to know what is causing this crisis, and what their government is doing to address it.

That's why over 117,000 people have signed a petition (which you can find [here](#)) calling on the government to release the report.

I would be very grateful if, as my MP, you could look into this extremely important issue on my behalf, and back the petition yourself. If parliament does eventually debate the petition, I would love to see you representing many of your constituents like myself who want to see the report published.
